

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT TEAM (IMT) TRAINING FOR ONSHORE STAFF

In order to have a competent response to offshore or plant emergencies, onshore, it is necessary to have an identified team onshore who are properly trained and have the responsibility to act in order to support the unit in trouble. This also involves careful management of the media thus protecting the Companies credibility.

With the hands on exercises the training will enable each individual Emergency Controller to gain experience and structure his / hers approach to emergency management
